The Router can serve as a DHCP Server, has a powerful SPI firewall to protect your PCs against intruders and most known Internet attacks, and supports VPN pass-through. Configuration is a snap with the web browser-based configuration utility.

With the Wireless-G Router for Mobile Broadband, you can create a secure wireless network with Internet connectivity, anywhere you can get mobile phone service.
